


Outdoor Kids Books!


Saturday August 11th, 2012 Michael Waddell, The Bone Collector is Coming To Charleston, WV!

Make your own Carp Bait -that works!

Some things you'll need

- 3 packets of strawberry gelatin
- A box of Quaker Oats (or similar)
- Strong mixing spoon
- A big mixing bowl
- Small pitcher of water
- Plastic container with cover

STEP 1:

Stir half a box of dry oats and all three gelatin packs in the bowl.

STEP 2:

Start adding small amounts of water and stir well. The mix should start to harden right away.

STEP 3:

Keep stirring, if the mix is too soupy, add more oats. If it gets too dry, add very small amounts of water. The idea is to get the mix to a clay-like consistency.

STEP 4:

When the mix hardens (and it's too hard to stir anymore) you can knead it with your hands. Once you can't knead it anymore, the bait is ready to set overnight in a covered plastic container.

STEP 5:

Go fishing! Here's how:

Pinch a grape-sized portion of the bait (or smaller) from the container and carefully mold around a small treble hook. Be sure to put the lid back on the bait, to keep it from drying out.

Bait is best fished under a small bobber and replacing it every 20 minutes or so to keep it fresh is also a good idea. Good luck!
